Advice Note:

If you are playing the [D] as a barre chord, by keeping your fingers in the same position, and by moving your fretting hand 3 frets down (or to the left) of your fretboard, your fingers will automatically take up the shape of the [B] barre chord for the next line of the verse. Try to dwell on each of the first 2 frets for a brief moment as you move your hand down the fretboard, to give a slight stutter to the slide when you strum.

The same applies when moving back 3 frets up (or to the right) of the fretboard i.e., from the B-Barre to the D-Barre chords.

Advice Note:

This is the longest slide up the neck in this song, which sets you up for the next verse. If you can play the F# as a barre chord , as you slide your hand, quickly, 4 frets up the neck, move your middle finger from the 2^{nd} (E) string to the 3^{rd} (C) string – this way you will automatically end up on the D-Barre chord to start the next verse.
